

## What to Bring – Stage 2

- □ Warm sleeping bag/ bed linen/ blankets, pillow and pillow case, towel
- □ Clothing: Warm casual clothing (jeans, tshirts, jumper, beanie, scarf, gloves, etc), **raincoat**, hat, suitable outdoor footwear and socks
- □ Full formal uniform (including stockings and shoes) If your Girls' Brigade Company wears polo shirt and jeans, or if you are not in Girls' Brigade, please contact Jennie Wallace 0413 313 904 or <u>gldleadership@girlsbrigade.org.au</u> for appropriate dress requirements
- □ Toiletries, insect repellent, sunscreen, tissues, small water bottle, small hand gel
- Personal medication
- □ Torch (with spare batteries very important for your ECHO experience!)
- Bible, pens.
- □ NO extra notebooks, journals. We will provide you with a manual and journal for Course.
- □ For camping EVERYTHING MUST BE ABLE TO BE PACKED IN YOUR HIKING PACK
  - Hiking backpack (school bag is NOT suitable)
  - large garbage bags
  - billy
  - plate, bowl, mug, cutlery, tea towel
  - cooking gear/utensils for camping
  - suitable clothing and sleepwear for camping (for warm and cold weather)
- hexamine stove & cooking tablets (NO large cooking equipment & NO gas/liquid stoves)
- small pack of baby wipes (for hygiene needs)
- small trowel (essential needed to dig your toilet)
- foam bed roll & sleeping bag suitable for cold climate (NO air mattress or swags)
- small tent no bigger than 2/3 person (please check that all parts are included)
- NO chairs or other home comforts
- Dersonal Emergency Kit this is for your personal use while camping
  - Bandaids (not a whole box)
  - 7.5cm crepe bandage
  - Triangular bandage
  - Small non-stick dressings
  - Antiseptic wipes (eg MediSwab)
  - Antiseptic cream (eg Savlon)
  - Disposable towel (eg Chux)
  - Small re-sealable bag/container to pack it all in
  - Large re-sealable bag (for waterproofing)

- 3 large safety pins
- Packet of Matches in zip lock bag
- Small scissors and tweezers
- Latex gloves (not a whole box)
- Paper and pencil
- Needle and thread
- Whistle
- Spare shoe/boot lace
- Space blanket/foil blanket (essential) available in Big W/Kmart & Camping stores

Optional: camera

□ Sense of humour and willingness to participate in ALL activities!!

PLEASE DO NOT BRING: Valuable personal items or jewellery, mobile phones (as per agreement at registration), electronic equipment (laptops, etc).
